

ESTONIA ELAMUSPARK

RENTAL RULES AND DRIVER CONSENT

1. General provisions

These rules apply to all renters and drivers of Estonia Elamuspark off-road buggies. Their purpose is to ensure the safety of all participants and the responsible use of the vehicles.

2. Before driving

1. All drivers must complete Estonia Elamuspark's safety briefing before driving.
2. Driving under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or any other substance that affects reaction ability is strictly prohibited.
3. The seat belt must be fastened before driving and remain fastened throughout the ride.
4. A helmet is mandatory. Long hair must be tied back, and loose clothing, jewellery or other items must not interfere with safe vehicle operation.
5. Before driving, the driver must make sure that they understand the vehicle controls and the instructions given by the employee.
6. The driver confirms that their health and abilities allow them to operate the vehicle safely. Driving while severely tired or feeling unwell in a way that affects driving is prohibited. Any doubts or deterioration in wellbeing must be reported to staff immediately and the ride ended safely.
7. A minor may participate with the consent of a parent or legal representative. The representative must read the rules and ensure that the child understands the instructions. Before driving, staff check that the child meets the vehicle's restrictions, can reach the controls and knows how to use them. Booking for someone else's child does not replace consent from their legal representative.

3. On the track

8. Driving is permitted only on the designated track and in the correct direction.
9. Intentional collisions, ramming, forcing another vehicle off the track or any other aggressive driving are strictly prohibited.
10. When overtaking, drivers must consider others and avoid creating dangerous situations.
11. Hands, feet and other body parts must not be extended outside the vehicle while driving.
12. Drifting, doing doughnuts, intentional sideways sliding, driving on two wheels or any other dangerous manoeuvre is prohibited.
13. Keep a safe distance and choose a speed suitable for the track conditions, visibility and the movement of other drivers.
14. Leaving the track or intentionally driving into barriers, embankments, trees or other obstacles is prohibited.
15. It is prohibited to deliberately get the vehicle stuck, obstruct other drivers or use the vehicle for a purpose for which it is not intended.

Driver declaration

I confirm that I have read and understood these rules and agree to follow them. I understand the risks of driving and the conditions concerning breaches of the rules and compensation for damage caused through fault. For a minor, the signing parent or legal representative confirms their authority, consents to the child's participation and ensures the child understands the instructions. This declaration does not limit the service provider's statutory liability.

4. Breakdown or accident

16. In the event of a breakdown, accident or getting stuck, stop safely, raise your hand as a signal and wait for staff instructions. Report any damage noticed before driving to staff. Following an incident, the vehicle, driver, circumstances and damage are recorded, with photographs where possible. The driver may add their own explanation. Any claim is accompanied by reasons and a repair estimate or invoice.
17. Do not leave the vehicle without permission from an Estonia Elamuspark employee, except in an immediate life-threatening situation.

5. Liability

18. All instructions from Estonia Elamuspark employees and instructors are mandatory and must be followed immediately.
19. Estonia Elamuspark may stop a ride immediately if the rules are violated. No refund is provided for unused driving time.
20. All buggies have a remote safety shut-off system (kill switch). If an instructor or employee identifies intentional ramming, dangerous driving, endangerment of drivers or spectators, or a serious violation of these rules, they may stop the vehicle remotely and end the ride immediately. The driver may not continue or claim a refund for unused time or fees.
21. Safety instructions from Estonia Elamuspark staff must be followed immediately. This does not restrict the customer's right to submit a complaint afterwards.
22. When booking for several drivers, the booking holder undertakes to explain the rules to everyone before driving. Each adult driver must read and follow the rules; a minor needs their legal representative's consent. Staff explain the main safety requirements before driving. Making a booking does not automatically make the booking holder liable for damage caused by other adult drivers.
23. Before driving, each driver must have read and understood the rules and agree to follow them. Online booking confirmation does not replace other adult drivers' own agreement or consent from a minor's legal representative.
24. The driver is liable, to the extent provided by law, for damage to vehicles, equipment or other Estonia Elamuspark property caused by their culpable acts or omissions, including intentional or negligent breaches of the rules. Compensation covers justified and documented restoration costs causally related to the damage. Normal wear, pre-existing damage and technical failures beyond the driver's control are not payable by the driver. These rules do not exclude or limit the service provider's statutory liability.
25. Estonia Elamuspark reserves the right to refuse service or stop a ride immediately when necessary to protect drivers, spectators, employees or property.
